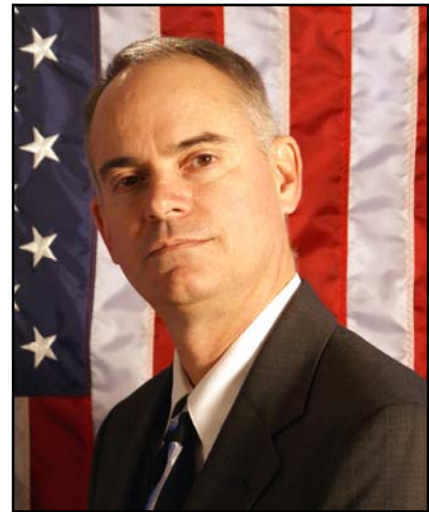

## **GARY B. CARNEY DIRECTOR**

Mr. Gary B. Carney, serves as Director of the U.S. Army Defense Ammunition Center. In that position, Mr. Carney leads an organization that serves as the center for ammunition logistical support and knowledge; responsible for explosives safety, logistics engineering, transportability, training, Depot/Garrison doctrine, demilitarization technology, supportability, reliability, technical assistance and career management. DAC is located at the McAlester Army Ammunition Plant, McAlester, Oklahoma. The organization provides worldwide support to all ammunition operations and activities.

Before coming to DAC in August 2007, Mr. Carney served as the Commander of the McAlester Army Ammunition Plant. He officially retired from the U.S. Army in October 2007 at the rank of colonel, serving 30 successful years in the military. Mr. Carney served as the Chief of Staff for the Tank Automotive and Armament Command in Warren, Michigan before assuming command of McAlester Army Ammunition Plant.



Mr. Carney's army career began in July 1977, when he was commissioned as a Reserve Army Ordnance Officer from the ROTC program at California State College, Pennsylvania. He entered active duty October 1977. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology from California State College of Pennsylvania and a Master of Science Degree in Logisticis Management from the Florida Institute of Technology. His military education includes the Ordnance Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, Army Command and General Staff College and a Master's in Strategic Studies from the Air War College.

During his career, Mr. Carney has served overseas in Turkey, Korea and Germany as well as at U.S. commands such as Tank Automotive and armaments Command (TACOM); Combined Arms Support Command (CASCOM), Training & Doctrine Command (TRADOC); Department of Army (DA), Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff, Operations and Plans (G3). Some of his assignments include serving as Chief, Nuclear Operations Branch, Maintenance Directorate at Rock Island, Illinois; Company Commander of the 78<sup>th</sup> Ordnance Detachment Special Weapons, 19<sup>th</sup> Support Command, Korea; Command Ammunition Officer, 55<sup>th</sup> Support Battalion, 56<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery Command, Pershing, United States Army, European Command (USAREUR); Commander of the 510<sup>th</sup> Special Weapons Company, 59<sup>th</sup> Ordnance Brigade, USAREUR; Training Ammunition Manager, DA, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff (G3); Ammunition Branch Chief, G4 USAREUR; and Commander of Toole Army Depot, Toole, Utah.

Mr. Carney's awards include the Legion of Merit with one Oak Leaf Cluster, Meritorious Service Medal with seven Oak Leaf Clusters and Army Commendation Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters.

A native of Pennsylvania, Mr. Carney is married to the former Barb Prosba and they reside in McAlester, Oklahoma. They are the parents of three sons and grandparents of three granddaughters.
